

**(AEAZM) Azumah finds two new gold zones**

Sydney - Thursday - July 19: (RWE Australian Business News) - **Azumah Resources** Limited (ASX:AZM) reports recently completed drilling programs totalling 2,617m at its Wa-Lawra Gold Project in Ghana have discovered two new zones of gold mineralisation 300 metres east of the existing 500,000-ounce Kunche deposit, with the potential to represent repetitions of the Kunche-style mineralisation and increase resources in the area.

In addition, follow-up air core drilling at Doggo North and Yagha South, located to the north of Kunche, has upgraded and extended the previously defined gold zones, while first-pass air core and reverse circulation drilling at a number of other prospects including Nanga has intersected further gold mineralisation.

Planning has already commenced for the next drilling campaign at Wa-Lawra, which will be designed to extend the existing Kunche resource along strike and at depth, extend the Kunche East discovery and infill drill the Doggo North Prospect.
