

(AEAZM) Azumah reports 'excellent' intercepts from Wa-Lawra

Sydney - Wednesday - February 20: (RWE Aust Business News) - **Azumah** Resources Ltd (ASX:AZM) has announced that assaying of individual one-metre drill samples from the recently announced Bepkong gold discovery at its 100 per cent-owned Wa-Lawra gold project in Ghana has returned an excellent intercept of 16m grading 4.9g/t gold from 50m, including 10m grading 7.1g/t gold from 54m.

These results, from discovery hole KRC 144, confirm the credibility of the discovery at Bepkong, announced in the December Quarterly Report.

The Bepkong prospect is located 2km north of the 516,000-ounce Kunche resource and was discovered by power-auger soil sampling that had previously returned anomalous values peaking at 1.3g/t gold.

The Bepkong soil anomaly is open to the north and south from where it extends semi-continuously 2km south back to Kunche.

It had not been previously drill tested.
